Eye problems

If you are experiencing an eye problem such as a stye or conjunctivitis you can be seen by a local optician participating in the Minor Eye Conditions Service (MECS).

HRT Prepayment Certificate

Patients who are prescribed certain types of HRT medication can apply for a prepayment certificate to cover the prescription charges. This works out considerably cheaper. Weight loss drugs

You may have seen on the news that weight loss injections will be available from the NHS from 23 June 2025. Services are currently being set up locally but are not anticipated to be available until the Autumn.

Once this service does become available, it will be for patients over 18, with a BMI of 40+, (or 37.5+ if you're from a Black, Asian or other minority ethnic background) and have four or more weight-related health conditions, such as Type II diabetes, hypertension and heart disease.
