Emails

Hampshire and Isle of Wight Integrated Care Board is setting a limit on the number of text messages we can send out. As a practice we will be looking to use email addresses where we have these for patients.

ADHD/Autism referrals and medication

Currently, there is a very long wait for patients to be seen for an autism/ADHD diagnosis. Many providers have reached their capacity for the number of patients they can see. We can only prescribe medication for ADHD if patients are currently being seen by a specialist provider and a shared care agreement is in place with them. NHS App

We would like to encourage all patients to request their repeat medication through the NHS App. This will help us to be more efficient as a surgery and ensures there is a record of your request. You can still use a paper request if you do not have internet access, but if you email your requests in, please consider using the NHS App instead.
